

- Dr. Hong is an expert in this field. It was great to learn from her, since she really really knows what she is talking about. The midterms were tough, but she adapted and allowed for corrections/equation sheet on the second. This flexability was really valuable. I loved the final interview and project, I got to learn about a really exciting topic. Her lectures were always on point, super interesting and very well organized. She is also so kind, available and helpful in office hours, and even had conversations before class to ask about how our coursework, interview for internships, and research papers were going. I can't wait to take Dr. Hong again, she is a great addition to the Trinity Economics Department
- I enjoyed this course. I'd already learned a lot of the concepts in the class so it wasn't too work intensive, but it was interesting.
- I really enjoyed this course--it was probably one of my favorite economics courses at Trinity. Dr. Hong is an amazing professor who helped make difficult topics easy to understand and who kept the class engaged even when covering objectively boring economic models. She is very knowledgeable about Industrial Organization, and her passion for the subject helped students feel engaged and excited as well. The class was difficult and the material challenging at times, but Dr. Hong was constantly available in office hours and via email to answer any questions and help students succeed.
- I took intermediate microeconomics with Professor Hong and liked her so much I just signed up for this class without looking at the course content.
- I took the course because I was very interested in antitrust and market structure. The segments of the course that were more conceptual when to use the Bertrand or Cournot model, how firms estimate price in practice, why firms vertically integrate, etc. were all extremely helpful and will stick with me. In particular, the use of real world case studies from antitrust law helped the concepts stick in my mind. I was less enthused about the more quantitative parts of the course. Here, I'm referring to rules like "marginal revenue is twice as steep as demand" and profit is Q*(P-MC).

- All the lectures had a specific outline that was followed. The allowance for test corrections and a study page for the exam made the tricky quantitative work much more manageable. Feedback was direct and quick. Office hours, especially right before the test, were very helpful.
- Dr. Hong always had PowerPoints for each chapter and lecture ready. Wish there were More office hours besides after class Monday and Wednesday but she was very available by email so this helped.
- Dr. Hong answers emails almost immediately, and always comes into lectures prepared for the topic of the day. She followed the syllabus to near perfection and I never felt lost in class. She is engaging, caring, and intellectual in the subject she teaches. She even brought in a guest lecturer to our class to discuss different implications of industrial economics in the world.
- Dr. Hong is always prepared. Her lectures are pretty engaging and she gives us time to talk in groups which is always nice. The games that we play to introduce concepts are fun too
- Dr. Hong is one of the most constructive and best economic professors I have had here at trinity. While the coursework is difficult, she ensures that every student has the chance to firmly grasp the material and perform well on the exams.
- Dr. Hong's exams were difficult. They covered a lot of what we discussed and went over in class and used models that we were familiar with from class discussions and homework problems. Dr. Hong created homework problems for us for each chapter that helped us better understand the material and gain experience applying the economic models we learned in class to real world problems. She was always available in office hours or in meetings to go over material from class, or even to discuss current events related to the class that students were passionate about (and helped steer those conversations in a way that helped us learn from them and better understand what we were doing in class).

- I really enjoy how Professor Hong uses class time to work through the concepts and problems and her use of the whiteboard (rather than just Powerpoint slides) makes it a much more interactive class. She also does a great job of using real world examples in her teaching.
- Office hours were consistent, and she added additional before tests. She also is very flexible and kind via email.

I like that Dr. Hong always incorporates real-world examples to clarify class content; it helps me see better the value of Industrial Organization beyond models and theories. This class—unlike most Econ classes—involves interactions with classmates and fun games, which help a lot in my understanding of the materials and are very rewarding.
- Yes, Dr. Hong is a very effective teacher. She explains concepts well, is open to questions, is flexible, and provides useful feedback :)
- Yes. Dr. Hong is great at explaining complicated economic concepts with vivid examples and case studies. The use of in-class experiments also made concepts stick very well. In the future, I would try to make the class 80% conceptual (case studies, in-class experiments, explanations of concepts like vertical integration) and 20% quantitative. I loved the use of the cheat sheet for the exam it made the quantitative work much more manageable. The reason I would reduce the quantitative amount is because it is intrinsically hard to understand, especially as undergrad students without much background knowledge.

I also really enjoyed the course's emphasis on research. The interview was fun and got me to understand real-world economics. I think one thing that would really make the course even more enjoyable would be integrating research into in-class discussions. Replacing some of the heavy quantitative work with discussion of papers would be awesome.








Histogram for scaled questions






Histogram for scaled questions






Histogram for scaled questions


